The Community planting day was a great success.

We now look forward to the Grand Opening on Saturday 15th May at 3pm, followed by a traditional Methodist Tea. All are welcome, do come. This will also be an opportunity to meet Revd Sarah Lowe.

The Church Meeting approved the launch of the appeal for £4,000. This is the estimated cost to reduce the size of the gents toilets, create a new corridor and give access to the garden through a new door as shown in this picture. We also plan an electrical socket (e.s.) for gardening equipment and new automatic lights for the side access path. An outside tap has been fitted to enable watering of the plants.

In response to the appeal, enough money has already been given to cover the electrical work (£616) and rearranging the toilet (£221) a further £1021 has been given which should be enough to create the corridor, just a door to go! The Church meeting also approved new windows for the lounge. The window shown to the left of this picture will be replaced with a double glazed, safety glass, picture window funded by the money donated at the Thanksgiving Service for Ella Garnham. In years to come it will give a lovely view of the garden.
